

Henry Michael Kearns - Henry's birth was registered in 1890, at Carlton, Melbourne, the son of Michael Henry and Annie Kearns (nee Cullen). He stated on his attestation form that he was born in Kilmore, and was a fishmonger. He enlisted on June 9, 1915 at Ballarat. After spending time at the Broadmeadows Camp where he acted as a sergeant, Henry was medically assessed and discharged on February 15, 1916. He married Nellie Carrington in 1923 and died at Oakleigh South in 1958.
